Some of our projects include :



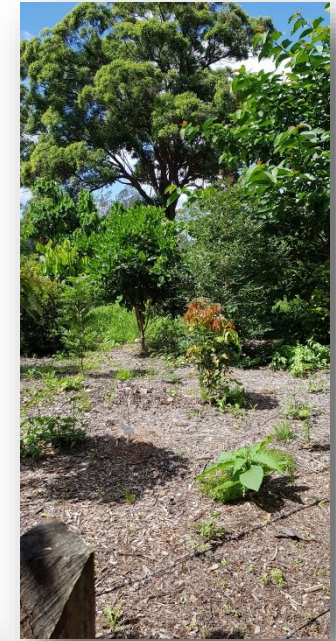
Restoration of river banks and habitat corridors
